- Teams must consist of 1-6 players.
  - Check-in begins at 1:00 pm for a start time of 1:30 pm.
  - All team-members who plan to participate must be present at check-in.
  - Each team will be given a 500-piece jigsaw puzzle that is unopened and in a closed bag. Teams are not allowed to see or open the puzzle until the official start of the competition and timer.
  - All teams will begin when the event host gives the signal and the timer is started.
  - Once their last puzzle piece is placed, teams are responsible for immediately notifying the event host to record their time and judge the completed puzzle.
  - The first team to complete their puzzle will be the winner and receive the first place prize. All other teams are encouraged to continue to work on their puzzle even after the winner is determined.
  - Teams may not bring any additional puzzle solving devices such as sorting trays, scoops, mats, magnifiers etc. They may use the box and bag the puzzle comes in, if desired.
  - All participants must use good sportsmanship and may not interfere with another team's ability to complete their puzzle in any way.
    - Participants can take snack, drink and bathroom breaks at any time, but their team's timer does not stop. No snacks or drinks, other than closed water bottles, at the puzzle table.
    - Teams get to keep their puzzle.
    - Most important of all, HAVE FUN!!
